Puerto Lempira is a town in the region of La Moskitia, a.k.a the Mosquito Coast.

Our mission will include these things ... *one-on-one Christian discipleship through meeting physical needs, educational tutoring, life-skills training, sports, Bible study and just plain old love.* Additionally, we have a heart for the entire community. We hope to immediately begin a neighborhood feeding program for malnourished children. Using the Texas A&M Junior Master Gardener program, we will encourage gardening with over 600 packages of seeds collected by FUMC Plano kids. Our future dreams include a micro-finance program, hosting short-term mission groups and developing a college internship program for Christian students to serve alongside our family.

The Work

Familia Alastero

After tragedy hit several members of this family, five ladies (tias) joined together to care for 29 orphaned nieces and nephews. Our visit with Familia Alastero was humbling. They all sleep on the floor. They do not have a source for clean water nor do they have a bathing/bathroom facility. And yet, the tias were the most gracious, God-loving women we met. It was an honor to visit their immaculate home. The children were overwhelmed by the very small gift of a soccer ball. Our 2010 team will build bunk-beds at this home. Our long-term work will include clean water, sanitation, weekly Bible club and showering them with God's love.

Mama Tara's Orphanage

This home for children was started by a woman who is known to all around as 'Mama Tara.' Mama Tara is a Miskito woman who was the governor of the province during the Nicaraguan Contra time in Honduran history. She is a strong, beloved woman in the La Moskitia region. Her heart is huge for orphans – both true orphans whose parents are deceased and social orphans whose parents refuse to provide care. We hope to assist Mama Tara long-term with weekly Bible club, discipleship, tutoring and life skills.

House of Hope (Casa Esperanza)

In 2005, Dr. Tom Brian, an Allen dentist, started the House of Hope as an outreach to disabled children in La Moskitia. House of Hope is a home for these children – a place where their basic needs can be met. Dr. Brian has brought countless children to the U.S. for surgery for such things as cleft palate & club foot. House of Hope also has a school on-site. We are privileged to work with Dr. Brian & Katrina Engle (an amazing missionary who runs the House of Hope) in providing assistance with their malnourished baby program, tutoring, discipleship & sports opportunities.
