I believe we rose to that challenge.

During a time of extensive unemployment and economic stagnation due to the shutdown in Honduras, we are so thankful to have been able to continue paying our 46 staff members so they could continue caring for their own families while working so hard to care for our students and their families as well.

Despite classes ceasing for the majority of the year, we were able to get our 85 graduating students in towards the end of the semester to finish their credits and examinations.

# College Scholarship Program

While not every one of our students dream of college, many do, and we desire to prevent financial barriers from hindering their education and development after they leave Abundant Life Institute.

Our vocational tracks provide two years of practical learning designed to develop the skills needed to enter the workforce immediately upon graduation or to give our students a preparatory edge before continuing their studies elsewhere. As one of our College Scholarship recipients, Elsa Jimena is now studying Tourism at University in Roatan where she

is living and studying near family. We are so proud of Jimena and her hard work and are so excited to see where her career takes her!

# Our Covid Response

While the changes and challenges from the pandemic have been seen and felt globally, the implications of the shutdown in Honduras for remote regions like ours have been drastic.

With the majority of our student's parents being day laborers, the shutdown meant significantly fewer work opportunities this past year during a time in which all our students were home and not receiving our normal two meals a day after schools were closed. The compounding effect of these two factors created an emergency situation for many of our student's families.

#### PHASE 1

With class out of session, we immediately shifted our focus to providing critical nutritional support to as many of our families as we could to help offset their food expenses. Throughout 2020, our teachers executed three rounds of food distribution of basic and long-lasting staples.

244 food bags distributed (focus on families needing urgent assistance)

#### PHASE 2

The second phase of our response was developing and distributing supplemental curriculum packets to help keep students busy at home (and staying refreshed with materials.) Our teachers developed three rounds of packets for their respective

grades, delivered them to their student's homes (which for some involved several hour trips out into surrounding villages), and followed up to grade and answer questions upon completion.





#### Our Covid Response

#### PHASE 3

The third phase of our response was making the necessary preparations and updates around the school to ensure we could open back up when possible. This involved the construction and installation of a hand-washing station and making enough masks for all our staff and students. We partnered with Dr. Marianne Serkland and a group of our students in her neighborhood to get 500 masks made and provide payment for their work as well.

#### PHASE 4

Additionally, we are so thankful and proud to say we were able to continue paying all of our staff's salaries at 100% throughout 2020. This meant they were able to continue providing for their families during a time of widespread unemployment and scarcity in the region.










#### **Hurricane Relief**

# Generous Help

After an already difficult year, October and November brought two back-to-back category 4 and 5 hurricanes that both directly hit the Mosquito coast and only two weeks apart from each other. Homes were damaged, crops depended on by thousands flooded, and many from the surrounding rural villages were displaced due to flooding and evacuations into Puerto Lempira.

Thanks to our amazing community who gave generously to quickly help our staff respond to needs on the ground, we were able to:

- Donate food to evacuation shelters as Iota moved in: 12,000 lemps (\$500)
- Repair roofs and homes in our area (fixing seven of our student's families homes): 36,000 lemps (\$,1500)
- Distribute more food support to 40 families

#### Our Vision for 2021

While we are thankful to have been able to return to face to face classes, this has had to happen with a modified schedule of shorter and fewer days. Recovering from the year off is going to take time, and the reality is that the implications of the Pandemic are still yet to be fully seen on the ground in Honduras since the situation continues to evolve.

This reality makes your involvement and contribution all the more critical as we work to support our students and the community of La Mosquitia in every way that we can.

- Resettling our students back into their studies after a year of disruption.
- Planning for a new Vocational Track to possibly launch in 2022 for 11th and 12th graders; adding Agricultural Engineering to our current program options of Tourism and Accounting / Finance.



#### Our Programs



Abundant Life Institute is a Christian middle and high school for grades 7–12 located in the remote La Mosquitia region of Honduras. Our students come from economically-challenged backgrounds. Middle school and high school are financially out of reach for most, even the public school which charges for uniforms, books, school supplies and exams.



#### **Adult Education Program**

Every Saturday morning at 6:00 a.m., adults from around Puerto Lempira arrive on the school campus for a one-year program to receive their high school education. It inspires the soul to watch these moms and dads sacrificing their Saturdays to reach the goal of receiving a diploma.



The College Scholarship Program was born in 2018. With these funds, we provide as many college scholarships to Abundant Life graduates as possible. Currently, we have students studying computer engineering, architecture, English, nursing, etc. under this program. Any donation to this program is greatly appreciated. For \$250 per month, you, your church or small group can sponsor a scholarship for one student.



#### **New Life Project**

Teen pregnancy in Central America often brings an end to a young woman's education. Cultural pressures, responsibilities with children, lack of commitment by fathers and many other difficulties prevent teen moms from continuing their education.
