



Dear Friend of Reach Out Honduras, One of the greatest joys of being part of Reach Out Honduras—aside from visiting Puerto

Lempira firsthand—is witnessing the fruit of this ministry in the ever-unfolding stories of our students and graduates. This month we celebrate our **8th graduating class**, bringing our total to **693 precious individuals** we’ve had the honor to walk alongside to high school graduation—a *milestone that fewer than 8% of low-income youth in the region ever attain.*

It has been such a gift this year to watch alumni step boldly into the dreams God has placed before them—**Cresler**, beginning his dream job as an elementary teacher in a remote village; **Wislami**, who graduated as an **Anesthesia Technician** through our College Scholarship Program and was immediately hired into a tenured position; and **Dorian**, who once walked three hours round-trip to school and has now been accepted to **medical school** at one of Honduras’ most competitive universities.

Each story is a beautiful testament to what’s possible when faith, opportunity, and perseverance come together—the living fruit of your generosity and God’s faithfulness in action.

Our journey with students begins years before these success stories are written. This school year we welcomed **83 new seventh graders**,

celebrated **90 graduates**, and saw more than **300 others** progressing toward their goals. Each day, our students are met with nourishment, safety, and a community that believes in them. They encounter God’s heart and word through weekly Bible classes, worship, and discipleship groups.

Through accessible education and holistic care, we are seeing hope restored as students gain the tools to provide for their families, **build brighter futures**, and live into the fullness of God’s promises for them.

With every inspiring story of student success though come the realities of rising costs and growing needs. Amid the great joys and challenges in this season of growth and change, **we are ever thankful** for God’s perfect provision, even as we navigate the uncertainties and realities of a complex economic climate.

As we work toward long-term financial stability, we’ve made the difficult decision to pause **our New Life and Accelerated GED Programs for 2026**, which provide a part time path to graduation for adolescent mothers, working youth, and adults.

This will allow us to **focus our resources on our full-time 7th–12th grade programs**, as we remain committed to providing safe, accessible, Christ-centered education and holistic care to the best of our ability, and to building an organization capable of serving the community of La Mosquitia for many years to come.
